Variety Grenache Region McLaren Vale

#### Nose

Raspberry liquorice, rose petals and cranberries.

#### Palate

Bright, juicy berries tempered by a spicy element rolls out on a velvet carpet of plush tannins and vibrant acidity.

## Pair

Beef carpaccio or heirloom tomato salad.

## Winemaking

Bush vines were handpicked and trellised vines were selectively harvested. Wild fermented with roughly 15% whole bunch fermentation overall with 3 weeks on skins. Matured for 10 months in seasoned barriques. Full and spontaneous MLF.

## Vineyard

Rayner Vineyard, Blewitt Springs, McLaren Vale. Unknown clone on own roots, planted late 2010's 100m elevation, North aspect. Blewitt Springs sand over limestone. Bush vines, goblet pruned and VSP spur pruned with catch wires. Sustainably managed.
