# Winemaking

Harvested in the morning. 90% destemmed, 10% whole bunches. Fermented with wild yeast for 1 week on skins. Pumped over twice daily. Gently pressed to stainless steel for 6 months. Full and spontaneous MLF.

Blewitt Springs, McIaren Vale. Unknown clone on own roots, '90s. 180-190m elevation, N aspect. VSP spur pruned on permanent cordons. Renmark, Riverland. Unknown clone planted on own roots in the '80s. Red sand on limestone. VSP Spur pruned on permanent cordons.
